

APPLICATION CHECKLIST

The Asian Institute requires documentation of the following for admission into the Master of Acupuncture or Master of Acupuncture and Oriental Medicine degree programs:

- Two years of accredited college or university study (90 quarter credits or 60 semester credits).
- Ninety (90) hours of Anatomy and Physiology (may be taken concurrently as a co-requisite during the first year of the program.)
- One course each in biology, chemistry and microbiology from an accredited college or university (may be taken concurrently as a co-requisite during the first year of the program.)

- _____ \$25.00 non-refundable transcript evaluation fee for transfer credit requests
- _____ One to two page autobiographical sketch that describes your reasons for pursuing this course of study and why you want to attend Asian Institute of Medical Studies.
- _____ Complete, up-to-date resume
- _____ Two letters of recommendation to support your application (to be mailed separately by those individuals)
- _____ Physician's letter (from MD, DO, DC, or Acupuncturist) attesting to your ability to undertake a rigorous program of study.
- _____ Physical exam with proof of negative PPD (tuberculosis test) on form provided by AIMS.
- _____ Official transcript(s), sent directly from the degree granting college or university, showing at least 60 semester credits or 90 quarter credits of college.
- _____ Two recent passport sized photos for student identification cards, when admitted.
- _____ Documentation of an acupuncture treatment.
