The Asian Institute requires documentation of the following for admission into the Master of Acupuncture or Master of Acupuncture and Oriental Medicine degree programs:

- Two years of accredited college or university study (90 quarter credits or 60 semester credits).
- Ninety (90) hours of Anatomy and Physiology (may be taken concurrently as a co-requisite during the first year of the program.)
- Biology, chemistry and microbiology from an accredited college or university (may be taken concurrently as a co-requisite during the first year of the program.)

_____ Physician's letter (from MD, DO, DC, or Acupuncturist) attesting to your ability to undertake a rigorous program of study

_____ Two recent passport sized photos for student identification cards when admitted

_____ Documentation of an acupuncture treatment
